

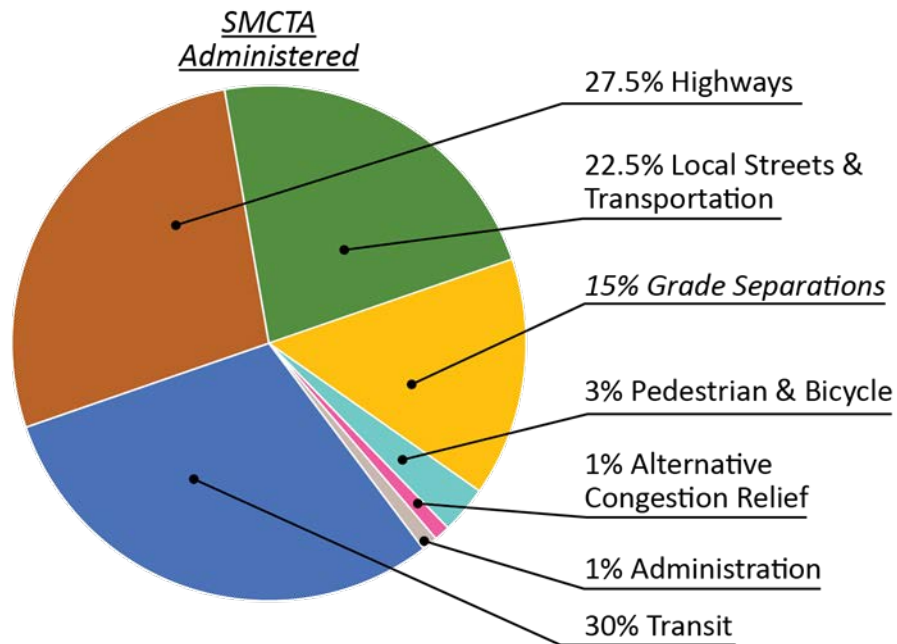

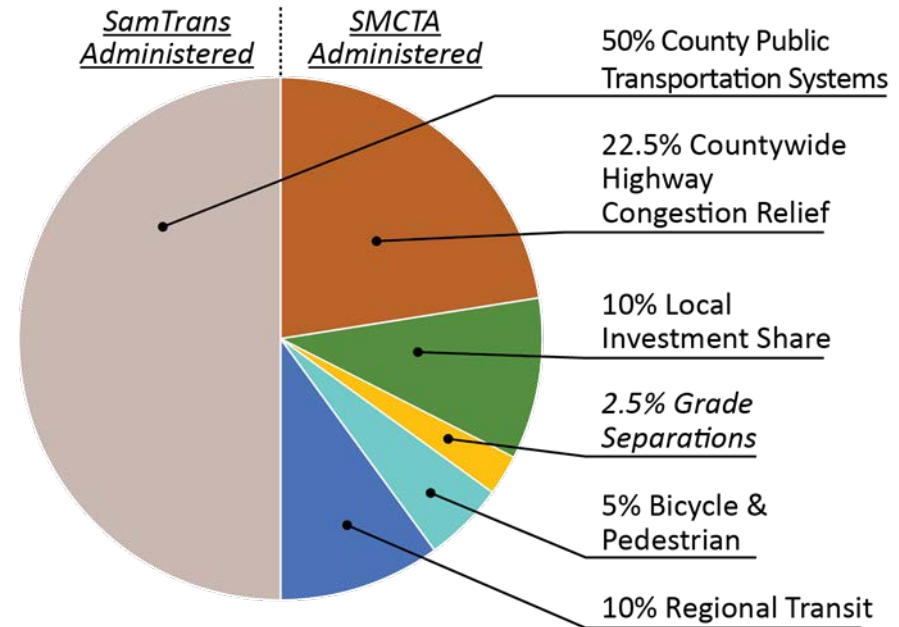

- **Local Streets and Transportation**

- Return to source—sales tax funds provided directly to local jurisdictions to maintain local streets and roads
- Funds can be used to implement green infrastructure
